Adavus are the basic dance steps in Bharathanatyam. The technique of any classical dance rests on the sturdy base of the adavus. An Adavu is defined as "The basic rhythmic unit of dance within a specific tempo and time structure that involves composite movements pertaining to Nritta".

In South Indian temples, devadasis (dancers dedicated to the Lord who are also the servants) used to perform Bharatanatyam.
