Stick the tissue onto the sticky side of the contact paper and overlap edges so it is completely covered. It's okay if it goes over the edges, it will be trimmed up later. Step Four: Now cut a piece of contact paper larger than your image to lay on top of the leaf and seal in the tissue paper. Go ahead and cut it to match the shape of the original leaf.
